### Shoes

At the front of the school is a banner that reads, "We all have different shoes to fill, but we are all discovering God's world together." At our first chapel we looked at our shoes and our feet, taking the time to notice how different we are, and that God has made each of us unique, right down to our toes and the shoes that cover those toes. We also talked about the places that our feet can take us, recognizing that our feet are great tools for exploring and discovering.

This year our theme verse, Jeremiah 33:3, tells us that God is ready to show us "great and unsearchable things." Already this year, students have been discovering new things. They have reconnected with old friends and possibly discovered some new friends along the way. They have discovered that kale is an amazing vegetable and that to make pickles you need to follow some very important and specific steps. Students' feet have taken them swimming at Kawkawa Lake and to the grand opening of Skwahalook First Nation Adventure Park. They have discovered that picture books can be read by all ages and that names are a powerful piece of who we are.

God has given us feet to discover, but at ACS we are using every part of our being to discover His world and our part in it. I am convinced that it's going to be a great adventure.
