## An inside • • ... into Preschool.

Our preschool classes have grown this year, and the preschool room is a place full of growth and discovery!

We have had many themes throughout our year, learning about class routines, community helpers, and dinosaurs to name a few. In our 4's class, we also do a program called "Fun Family Phonics", where the children learn a letter every week, with the sound that it makes. Now that it is getting close to the end of the year, the children are learning two letters every week.

Each of the classes has been on a farm field trip, and the 4's class got to visit the Agassiz Fire Station. The children enjoyed climbing into the fire trucks and learning what it's like to be a firefighter. They even let the parents (and teachers) use the jaws of life, which was an exciting experience for us.



As a school, we desire to see children Discover, Grow, and Thrive. Children are learning communication skills, problem solving skills, and building a foundation for success in learning throughout their school years. Most of all though, my prayer is that they have a seed planted in their hearts about how much their Heavenly Father loves them.



Miss Amy has been doing a Bible circle each class, and the children have also been learning a verse every month. At Easter this year, we were discussing the death and resurrection of Christ. I was trying to explain the Trinity concept to the children and brought in a hard boiled egg to do so. I peeled the egg and separated the yolk from the egg white. I then explained that just like an egg has three parts, so does God. We have God the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Even though we only have one egg, there is the shell, the egg white, and the yolk. After the lesson, I cleaned up my egg mess. As I was walking to the garbage can, one of the boys burst out, "She's throwing away God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit." All the children laughed, and I was glad they had learned the lesson... I hope.
